DREDGING PLAN REVIEW

Commissioner Poyntz provided an overview of proposed Dredging plans. For 2022, the Committee approved to consider dredging the areas: Gondola Lagoon at the Mews (**Map K**), Gondola Lagoon between the North Footbridge and the Pinetree Court bridge (**Map F**) and possibly the unloading section at the end of Cedar Lagoon (**Map B**). Deputy Mayor Gough also confirmed he would discuss with M.P. Chambers to request federally-funded dredging at the spit.

BEAVER TRAPPING AT 100 LAGUNA PARKWAY

The Commission approved for the Maintenance Contractor to clean-up any beaver den remains in the spring of 2022 as part of the canal maintenance spring clean-up duties.

2022 WEED HARVESTING

The Director of Infrastructure reported that the new weed harvester is estimated to be delivered in 9-14 months. As a result, the Commission approved to investigate pricing regarding rental of a weed harvester in the event it is required in 2022.
