We are committed to building community partnerships in order to promote economic initiatives and environmental stewardship.

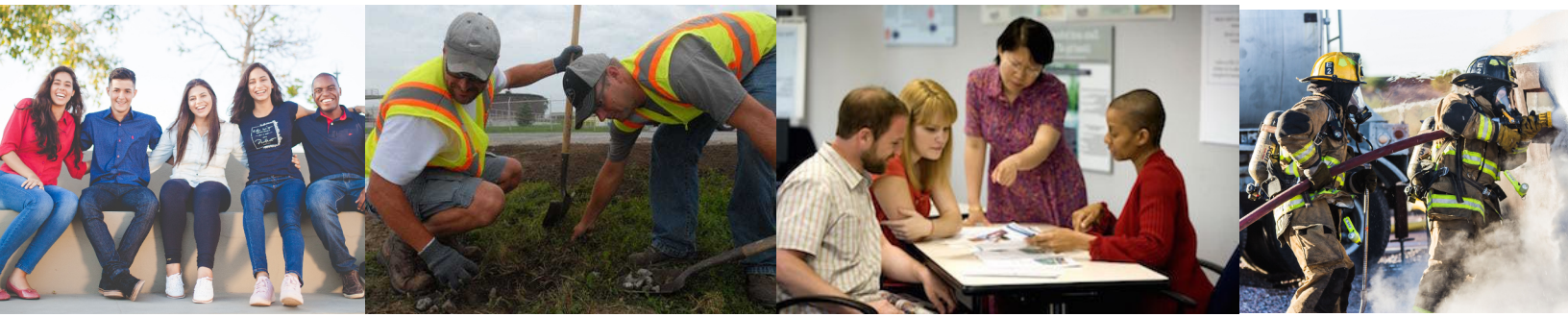


STRATEGIC DIRECTION

SERVICES

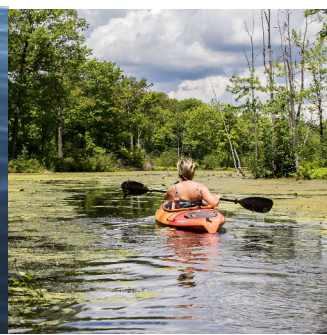
Goal: Provide services and infrastructure that addresses the needs of our growing community.

- Develop a Waterfront and Park plan with focus on parking and signage at Beaches, Parks and Trails
