On behalf of the LCPW Commission, I wish all of you a happy 2019 and safe travels for the snowbirds.

LCPWC have approved a 20 year dredging plan for the canal system in Lagoon City. Each year the plan calls for 300 meters of canals to be dredged. The first area will be HARBOUR LAGOON it will be done in 2 sections, 2019 requires 325 meters to be dredged starting at the east end of the lagoon. The remaining part of lagoon's 330 meters will be done 2020.

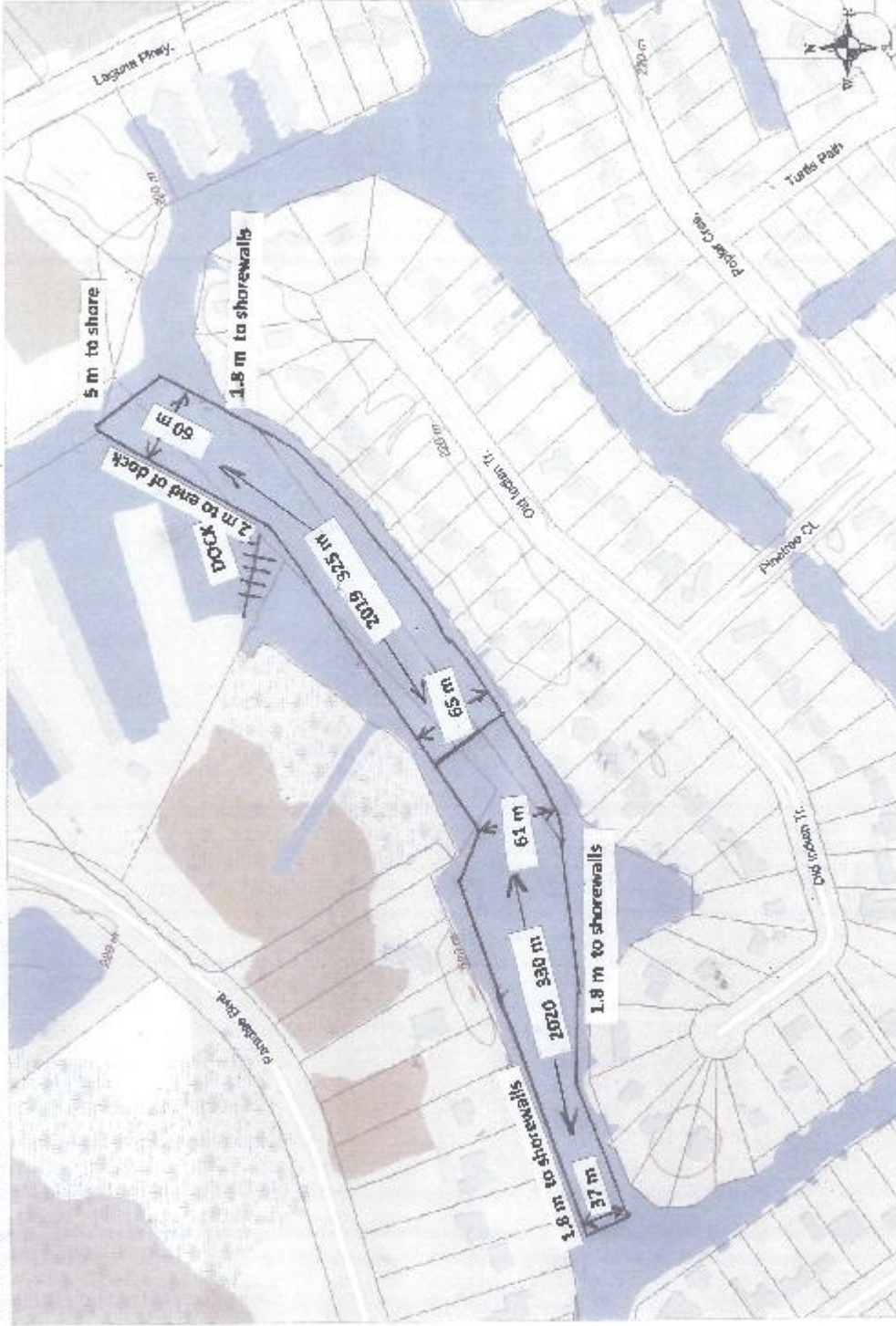
- MAP A **GONDOLA LAGOON**, across from the Yacht Club. (150 meters)
2018 Sept. Depth of water between 1.4 m to 1.6 m, with .3 m (1 foot) of heavy mud. (NEW DATE 2026 SAME TIME AS HARBOUR ENTRANCE MAP D).
- MAP B **CEDAR LAGOON**. (40 meters) If LCPWC are going to go ahead with the unloading spot at the end of Cedar Lagoon.
Not measured.
- MAP C **HARBOUR ENTRANCE**. (230 meters) Needs to be dredged in 2022 and 2034.

- MAP D **HARBOUR ENTRANCE**. (150 meters) Needs to be dredged in 2026 and 2030.
2018 Sept. Depth of water between 1.4 m to 1.58 m, no mud.
- MAP E **HARBOUR LAGOON**. (Two sections of 325 meters each) to be dredged: first section in 2019, second section in 2020. *2018 Sept. Depth of water between 1.4 m to 1.8 m, with .3 m to .6 m (1-2 foot) of heavy mud.*
- MAP F **GONDOLA LAGOON**. (359 meters) to be dredged in 2021.
2018 Sept. Depth of water between 1.4 m to 1.8 m, with .3 m to .6 m (1-2 foot) of heavy mud. Less mud near bubbler and lighter in colour.
- MAP G **GONDOLA LAGOON**. (300 meters) to be dredged in 2023.
2018 Sept. Depth of water between 1.4 m to 1.8 m, with .3 m (1 foot) of heavy mud. Along new shorewalls less than 1 m deep.
- MAP H **WINDWARD LAGOON**. (300 meters) to be dredged in 2024.

2018 Sept. Depth of water between 1.4 m to 1.8 m, with .3 m to .6 m (1-2 foot) of heavy mud.

- MAP I **LEEWARD LAGOON.** (300 meters) to be dredged in 2025.
2018 Sept. Depth of water between 1.4 m to 1.8 m, with .3 m to .6 m (1-2 foot) of heavy mud.
- MAP J **SOUTH HARBOUR.** (300 meters) to be dredged in 2027.

- MAP K **GONDOLA LAGOON.** (375 meters) to be dredged in 2028.
2018 Sept. Depth of water between 1.6 m to 2 m, with .3 m to .6 m (1-2 foot) of heavy mud.
- MAP L **GONDOLA LAGOON.** (304 meters) to be dredged in 2029.
2018 Sept. Depth of water between 1.4 m to 1.7 m, with .3 m to .6 m (1-2 foot) of heavy mud. Less mud near bubbler and lighter in colour.
- MAP M **GONDOLA LAGOON.** (225 meters) to be dredged in 2031.
2018 Sept. Depth of water between 1.6 m to 2 m, with .3 m to .6 m (1-2 foot) of heavy mud.
- MAP N **WINDWARD LAGOON.** (280 meters) to be dredged in 2032.
2018 Sept. Depth of water between 1.4 m to 1.8 m, with .3 m to .6 m (1-2 foot) of heavy mud.
- MAP O **LEEWARD LAGOON SOUTH.** (300 meters) to be dredged in 2033.
2018 Sept. Depth of water between 1.4 m to 1.8 m, with .3 m to .6 m (1-2 foot) of heavy mud.
- MAP P **HARBOUR LAGOON.** (170 meters) to be dredged in 2035.

- MAP Q **TURTLE LAGOON.** (800 meters, plus small lake which is approximately 6,000 square meters) to be dredged in 2036.
