In your home or where you work:

Don't put items such as these down the drain – put them in the garbage where they belong:

- Cigarette butts
- Dental Floss
- Condoms
- Rags
- Disposable dust cloths
- Tampons and tampon applicators
- Sanitary napkins
- Disinfecting Wipes
- Disposable diapers
- Disposable baby wipes
- Human and pet hair
- Cotton swabs
- Cosmetics/makeup
- Food scraps (better yet, compost them or dig them into your garden)
- Vegetable and animal grease, fats, oils (they can clog the sewer in your home and the Township system, and cause sewer backup)



Leftover or expired prescription drugs/over-the-counter. Take them to a pharmacy where they will be disposed of safely.

Household hazardous waste products. Common hazardous wastes include:

- Hypodermic needles
- Paint brush cleaners/solvents
- Chemical lawn fertilizers
- Gasoline
- Leftover paint
- Antifreeze (radiator/windshield)
- Household cleaners
- Weed, insect killer
- Swimming pool chemicals
- Used oil products
