BYLAW NO. 2018.15

BEING A BYLAW TO AMEND FEES AND CHARGES BYLAW 2017.18

WHEREAS Section 391 of the Municipal Act, 2001, provides that the Council of a municipality is empowered to pass Bylaws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it;

AND WHEREAS Council passed Bylaw 2017.18 on March 27, 2017 to impose fees or charges for the Township of Ramara;

AND WHEREAS Council entered into an Agreement with Fire Marque Inc. on February 12, 2018 by Bylaw 2018.12;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it necessary to amend Schedule "F" of Bylaw 2017.18 to include a fee to reflect the needs required under the Agreement with Fire Marque Inc.;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Township of Ramara hereby enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** Schedule "F" to Bylaw 2017.18 be repealed and replaced with Schedule "F" attached hereto;
2. **THAT** this Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of passing.
