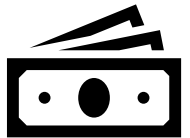

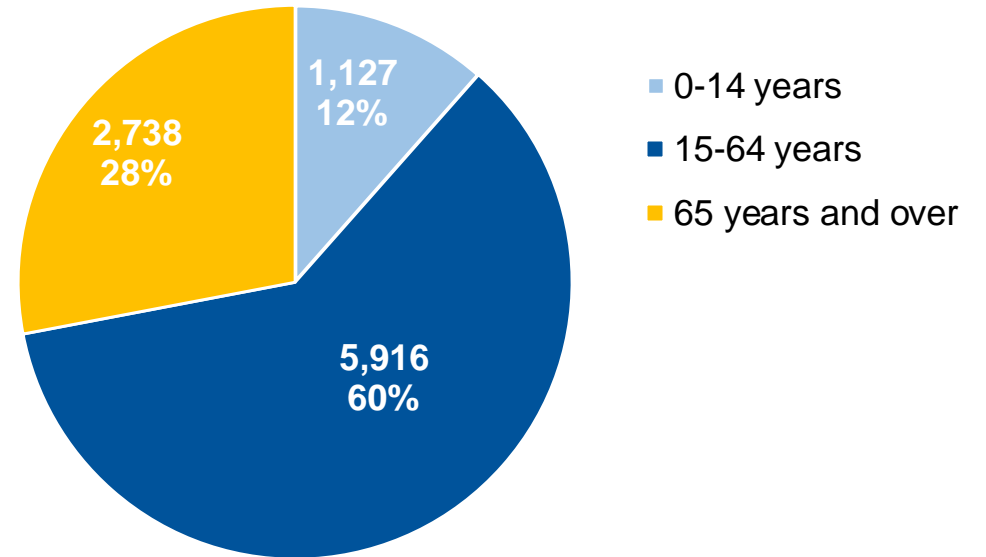

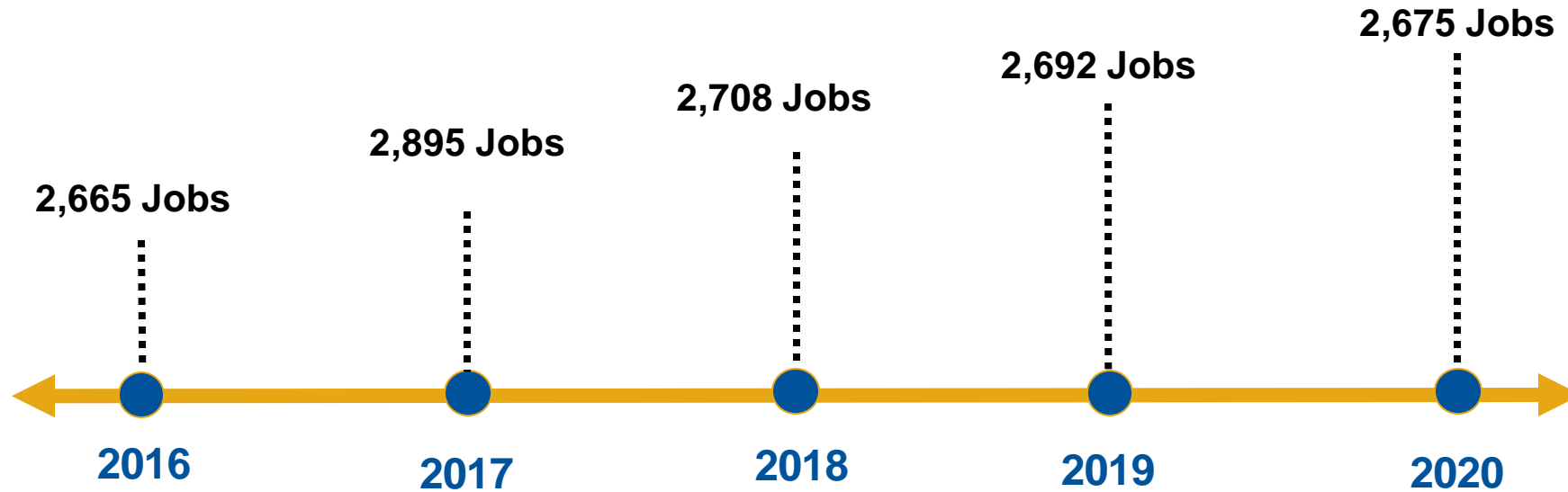

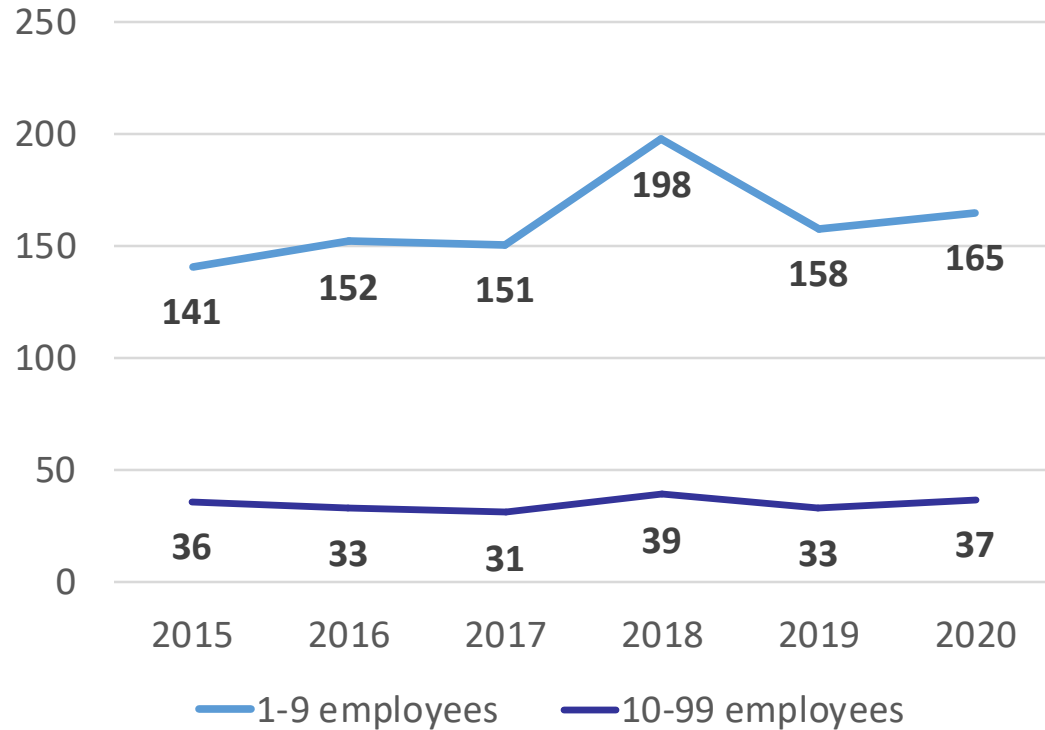

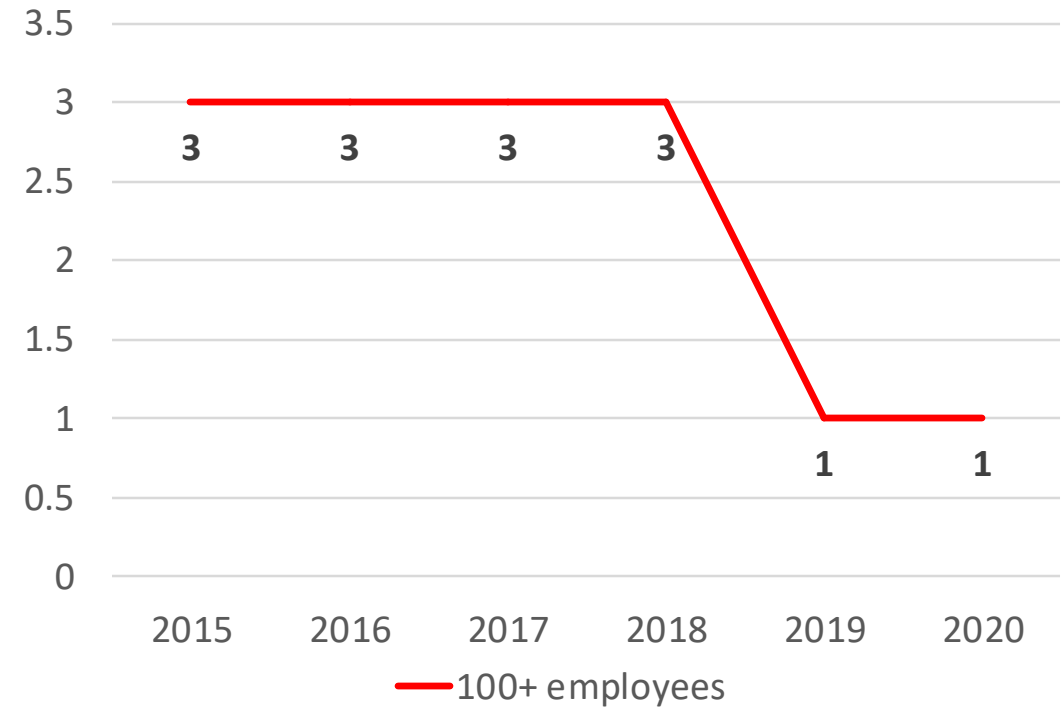


# Number of Employers 2015-2020

## Employers with 1-99 employees



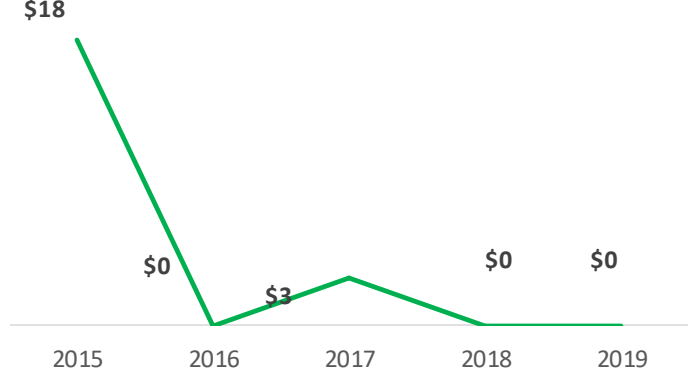
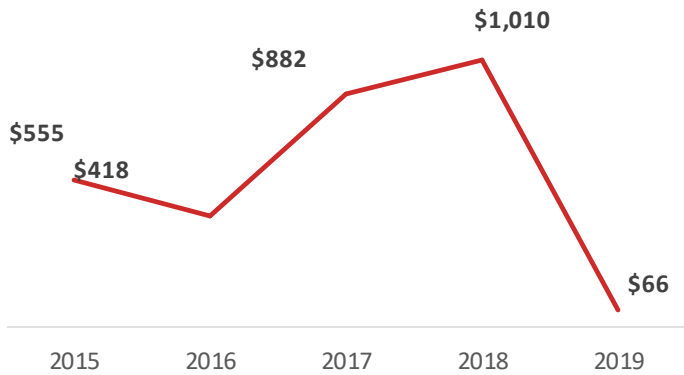
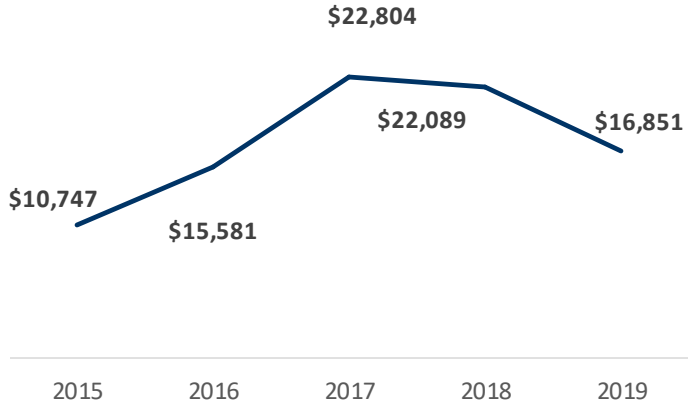
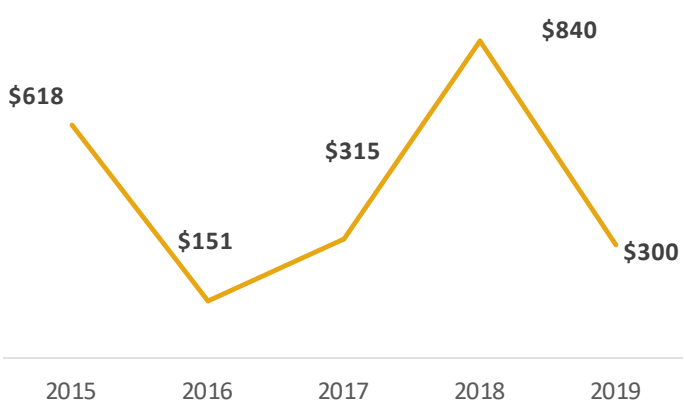

# 2015 – 2019 Building Permits Value (\$000)



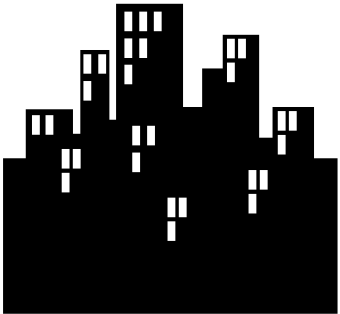

Industry Group Location Quotient Comparison

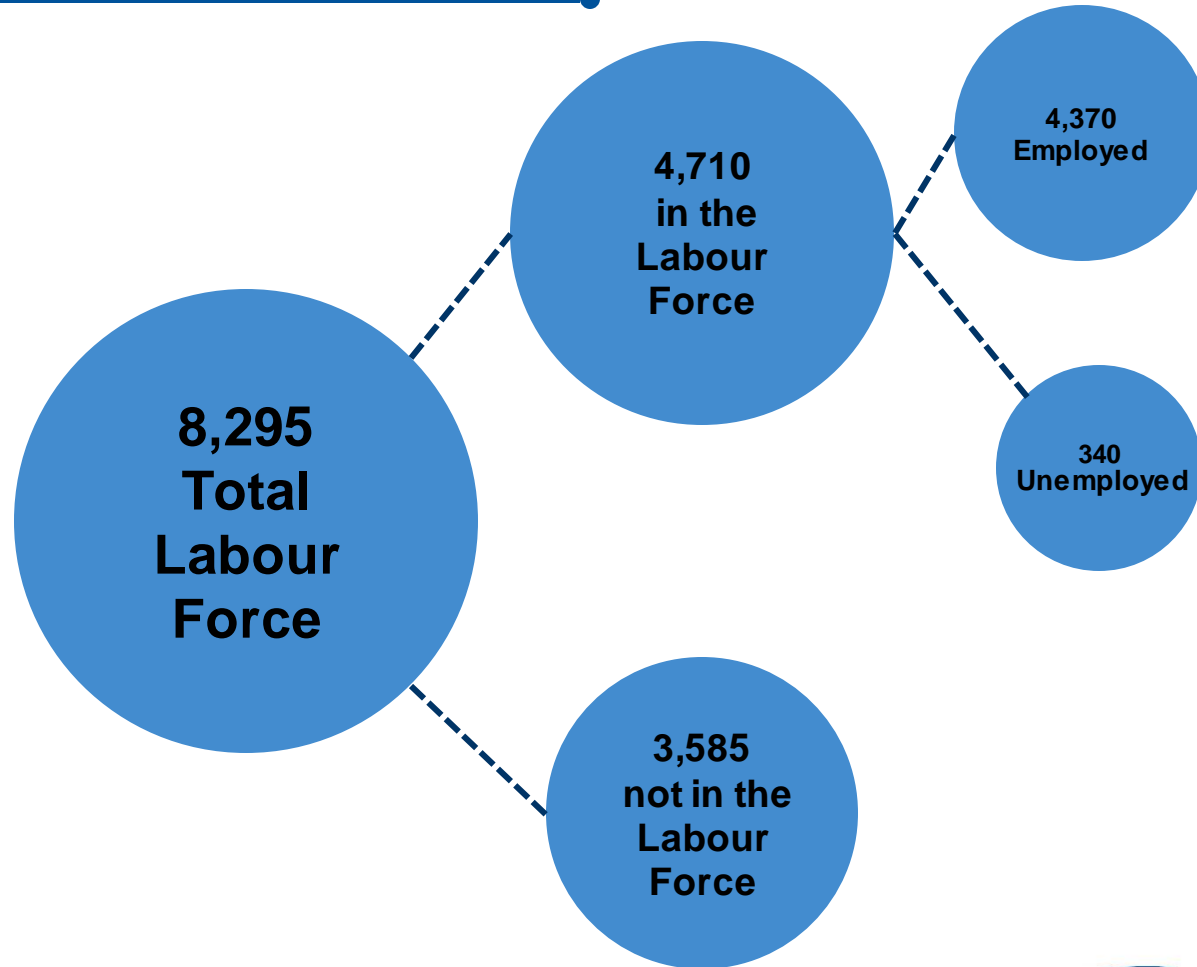
