Residential Building Permit Complete Application Checklist

Application Form – To be completed via Cloudpermit. <i>Note: For an additional</i>
fee, applications may be accepted via paper, and the standard Province
prescribed permit application form must be filled out entirely
Drawings for Project – Must be stamped by professional engineer/professional
architect or qualified designer with a current BCIN. Note: A property owner may
also design certain plans, provided that all details for construction of the
proposed, including required building materials are encompassed
Energy Efficiency Design Summary – This form is required for new
dwellings/habitable buildings, and often required for additions
Engineer Sealed Truss Drawings & Layout, TJI Floor and LVL's (if applicable)
Entrance Permit – Obtained from Township Infrastructure or County of Simcoe
(if applicable)
HVAC – Includes heat loss/gain, layout and calculations (if applicable)
Lot Grading Deposit Payment – Required for new dwellings and projects under
Other Applicable Authority Permit or Written Approval – Required for projects
within any other authorities area of regulation, such as the Ministry of
Transportation, Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry, Lake Simcoe Region
Conservation Authority, etc.
Owner/Designer Declaration – Required for plans designed by the property
owner
Owner Authorization Letter – To be included in each application and/or
Certificate of Incorporation (if applicable)
Payment
Residential Pre-Permit Zoning Approval with Grading Application Approved –
Applicable to projects 50 sq. metres or greater (Exemption applicable to Rural zoned or Agriculture zoned properties that are greater than 1.5 acres)
Road Allowance Deposit (if applicable)
Schedule 1 – Form required to be completed by the project plans designer
Schedule 2 – Form required to be completed by the project plans designer Schedule 2 – Form required for septic projects
Separate Permit Application – Required for septic projects, each detached
structure, and demolition (per structure)
Septic Calculations (if applicable)
Septic Verification Form (if applicable)
Site Plan – Required for all applications (including demolition). For interior works,
please submit a detailed floor plan

NOTE: Dependent on project proposal, additional items may be required to ensure compliance with the Ontario Building Code, as well as all other applicable law.
