**IMPORTANT NOTICE**  
**TO ALL USERS CONSUMING WATER FROM RAMARA DRINKING WATER SYSTEMS**

Recent routine testing of drinking water from the following municipal water treatment plants revealed that sodium levels exceed 20 mg/L.

We are required under the Safe Drinking Water Act to report to the Medical Officer of Health when sodium levels exceed 20 mg/L. This information is made available to local physicians in order to help persons on sodium-restricted diets control their sodium intake.

We are required to sample for sodium in treated water every 5 years. This advisory will remain in effect until test results indicate that sodium concentration levels fall below 20 mg/L.
