If we cannot read your meter, you will receive an estimated bill and a letter notifying you that an appointment is needed to fix the problem.

IF YOU DO NOT CALL for an appointment before the recommended date, INCREASED BASE FEES will be applied to your account until an appointment is scheduled to fix the problem.

### **Backflow**

The Township is responsible for protecting our municipal water system from pollutants and contaminates. Water is intended to flow in one direction, so any undesirable flow reversal from a facility or building back into the drinking water system could lead to water contamination and lead to human health and safety concerns.

### **Backflow Prevention**

The Township's Engineering Design guidelines outlines the requirements for installing a backflow preventer at the meter. This device ensures that water that has already passed through the meter into a building doesn't flow back into the water main. This is known as a closed system. If a backflow preventer is installed, then the Ontario Building Code requires a thermal expansion tank to be installed as well.

It's important to note that all piping and required equipment (backflow preventer and pressure tank) that comes after the municipal shut-off valve on the street is considered private plumbing. Every resident is responsible for maintaining their private plumbing and ensuring that it is in good condition.
