Road Sweeping

Road sweeping operations are scheduled to start around the middle of May to the beginning of June and will continue day/night until completed. **Remember** to avoid parking on the road or move when you see the equipment.

Road grading operations are starting on all of our gravel roads. Did you know that in order to effectively grade a road, there should be three rainless days (the day before, the day of and the day after).

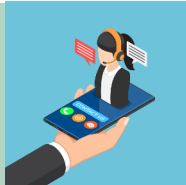
