

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RAMARA

BYLAW NO. 2004.42

BEING A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW 2003.52 BEING A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE PARKING OF VEHICLES WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF RAMARA

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, Section 101(2) and the Highway Traffic Act, Section 170(2) provides that a municipality may pass a bylaw to regulate or prohibit the parking or leaving of a motor vehicle on land owned or occupied by the municipality or any of its local boards without the consent of the municipality or local board, as the case may be, it may provide for the removal and impounding or restraining and immobilizing of any vehicle, at the vehicle owner's expense, parked or left in contravention of the bylaw.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Ramara passed Bylaw 2003.52 on the 28th day of July, 2003 to regulate the parking of vehicles on certain roads within the Township of Ramara;


NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Township of Ramara hereby enacts as follows:


- 1) THAT Schedule "A" of Bylaw 2003.52 be amended to add the following permanent no parking areas:

	<u>Street</u>	<u>Location</u>
20	Henry Street	both sides a distance of 30 metres south from the intersection of Highway 12
21	Unopened Road Allowance between the former Townships of Mara and Rama	north side a distance of 33 metres west from Fawn Bay Road

- 2) THAT this Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of passing.
