### **Mayor Update**

Mayor Clarke opened up the meeting and reported that he and other members of the Council attended Cliff Martin's retirement celebration on Saturday, June 24, 2023, which honoured Cliff's 46 years of volunteering for the Udney Community Centre Board. On behalf of Council and Township staff, we want to knowledge and thank Cliff for all his years of service, including his time and commitment to the Ramara community.

Mayor Clarke also advised that Council is in the process of updating Ramara's Strategic Plan with public consultations ending on June 30. He advised that he and other members of Council attended the Wards 1, 2 and 3 public sessions last week, and Wards 4 and 5 will be occurring on Tuesday, June 27 and Wednesday, June 28, 2023. #### **Brechin Subdivison - 2123 Concession Road 4**

MHBC, on behalf of their clients the Lagoon Country Life Management Inc. (Brechin subdivision's owners) requested the Council to formally extend the draft plan approval for the property at 2123 Concession Road 4. The current draft plan lapse date is July 22, 2023, and the requested extended date is July 22, 2025 - an extension of two additional years.

Council approved receiving the request as information and for the Lagoon County Life Management Inc. to come back to Council with more information on timelines, payments to outstanding invoices, etc., to consider the proposed extension.
