SOUTH FOOTBRIDGE REPAIRS UPDATE

Tim Collingwood and Brian Wood from Tatham Engineering provided an update on the status of the South Footbridge repairs. Based on the excavation, inspection, and age of the bridge, Tatham Engineering recommends that the Lagoon City Parks and Waterways Commission replace all four underground secondary connections located on each corner at an estimated cost of \$75,000. The Commission approved to authorize Tatham Engineering to proceed with the investigation and replacement of the four underground secondary connections.

WATERSIDE WISDOM SPEAKER SERIES - LAKE SIMCOE REGION CONSERVATION AUTHORITY PRESENTATION

Brian Ginn, Ph.D. Limnologist for the Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority (LSRCA) provided an overview of the LSCRA's responsibility and role in conserving, restoring and managing the Lake Simcoe watershed. Brian outlined key stressors to Lake Simcoe - phosphorous, invasive species and climate change, and key tips on how the public can help manage and improve the health of the Lake Simcoe watershed.

The Commission approved receiving the correspondence for staff to investigate the noise level and lattice option for covering the water mover and for the water movers to be turned on 24/7 in Gondola Lagoon - ahead of the August schedule.
