# Lagoon City Parks and Waterways Commission July 14, 2022

Commission approved for Deputy Mayor Joe Gough to remain Chair of the Lagoon City Parks & Waterways Commission for one (1) year.

#### **2022 DREDGING**

The Commission reviewed proposed dredging areas: **Harbour Lagoon**, **Harbour Entrance**, **Mews Back Lagoon**, **Cedar Lagoon** and **Gondola Lagoon**. The Commission approved the following areas for dredging for 2022.

- 1. 248 meters of canal at the Mews Back Lagoon
- 2. 315 meters of canal at Gondola Lagoon
- 3. Staff will investigate the need to dredge near the offloading ramp at Cedar Lagoon (Map B)

#### FEASIBILITY OF LATTICE COVERING THE WATER MOVER

The Commission received the report for information. The report outlined that a subframe and lattice could be constructed and installed on the water movers; however, the price of materials, including labour, would be \$3000 to \$5000 per water mover.

### **BRIDGE WORK IN LAGOON CITY**

Construction is scheduled to begin July 18, 2022, on Bridge #4, located on Pinetree Court between Old Indian Trail and Poplar Crescent in Lagoon City. Please be advised there will be no access to marine traffic under the bridge during this time.
