Lagoon City Parks and Waterways Commission June 8, 2023

2022 Draft Financial Statements

Director of Finance Manon Higgins presented the 2022 Draft LCPWC Financial Statements. The statements show that the LCPWC is in a strong financial position, with revenues and the annual surplus increasing yearly. The presentation also outlined that the Commission has been increasing its reserve funds over the past five years to help offset future asset replacement and capital projects.

Acoustic Assessment of Water Movers in Gondola Lagoon

As a result of noise complaints received regarding noise emissions from the water movers installed at Gondola Lagoon, the Lagoon City Parks and Waterways Commission approved for Tatham Engineering to prepare an Acoustic Assessment Report (AAR). This report will be completed in two phases.

- 1. Phase 1 will include data collection benchmarking and preliminary analysis of noise emissions in relation to MECP minimum noise criteria.
- 2. Phase 2 Modeling and Report Preparation (if required) If the noise omission exceeds MECP criteria, a report will be conducted with suggestions on how to reduce noise emissions.

The Commission approved for Tatham Engineering to proceed with Phase 1 - Data Collection - and, if required, Phase 2 - Modeling and Report Preparation.

Memo - Aquatic Weed Spraying

Aquatic weed spraying application is scheduled for Monday, July 17, 2023, with a weather date of July 18, 2023. Notices will be sent to property owners within the Lagoon City area.

South Footbridge Repairs

The Director of Infrastructure provided an update regarding the South Footbridge repairs. The contractor was on site on June 5, 2023, and noticed that the north-end cables had a broken strand not previously present. The cables are in good condition; however, one strand appears to have a localized defect that led to its breakage. The contractor will replace both cables with a 2-3 weeks proposed timeline.

Infrastructure Updates

• Engineers have been engaged regarding the future design and capital work of the North Footbridge.

- The fountain at the entrance to Lagoon City is out of order, and staff have ordered a new pump.
- The No Wake sign at the intersection of Leeward Lagoon South and Canoe Lagoon is sinking, and staff are in the process of locating a used tire and rim to fix the floating sign.
- The piping from Beaver Trail Clean Flo System has not been covered yet and the sound insulation has been added to the shed, but it requires soil to be added to the base.
- The new harvester and barge are operational; staff are awaiting training from the manufacturer on the new harvester.

- Residents are reminded to use the O.P.P. online tool Report a Crime for marine incidents. This will ensure that O.P.P. is contacted directly with the information and can use the reporting as statistical data for officer placement.
