
A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT DUMPING OF WASTE


WHEREAS the Township of Mara Act, 1986 and Section 219 of The Municipal Act R.S.O. 1990 Chapter M45 authorize the passing of bylaws with respect to the regulating and maintenance of canals, waterways, private parks and walkways within Lagoon City.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Ramara enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw "waste" shall mean ashes, garbage, refuse, domestic waste, grass, leaves, garden clippings and garden waste.
2. No person shall place, dump or dispose of waste in any canal, waterway or boatslip connected thereto, nor if any private park or walkway, owned by the Township and under the management and control of the Lagoon City Parks and Waterways Commission.
3. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw shall be subject to a fine of no less than \$250.00 and not more than \$5,000.00 and every fine imposed is recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act.

BYLAW READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND PASSED THIS 14th DAY OF APRIL, 1998.
