

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RAMARA
BYLAW NO. 2014.56

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT PERSONS FROM
FISHING OFF BRIDGES IN LAGOON CITY

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 102 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, chapter 392(1) and amendments thereto, Municipal Councils are empowered to pass by-laws and make such regulations for the health, safety, morality and welfare of the inhabitants of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Township of Ramara deems it desirable to pass a bylaw prohibiting individuals from fishing off bridges located above waterways or watercourses within Lagoon City;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Ramara hereby enacts as follows:

1. "Bridge" means a public bridge and includes a bridge forming part of a highway over a body of water.
2. No person shall fish from any bridge located above a waterway or watercourse within Lagoon City in the Corporation of the Township of Ramara.
6. The Bylaw Enforcement Officer or a Provincial Offences Officer is hereby authorized to enforce the provision of this bylaw.
4. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall be liable to a fine of not more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.
5. Schedule "A" shall form part of this Bylaw
5. This bylaw shall come into force and effect upon passing.
