Temporary Water Service Disruption Bayshore Village Water System

Please be advised that all properties on the Bayshore Village Water system will have their water shut off on <u>Tuesday, September 26 at 9:00 a.m.</u> for approximately 4 hours for water distribution system repairs.

In the event of inclement weather, work will be postponed until Wednesday, September 27.

We must temporarily shut off water to the system to replace a failed hydrant and secondary valve located at the water treatment plant. All properties connected to the municipal Bayshore Village water system will be affected during the repair.

During this scheduled time, you will be unable to access any water service; for example, accessing water from your sinks, shower or flushing the toilet. You are encouraged to plan accordingly for this by storing water during the interruption. Your sewer service will not be affected, meaning you can pour water down the drain from a container.

When water service is restored, water remains safe to drink; however, coloured water and air in the plumbing may be present.

Customers are encouraged to flush their water lines with cold water once work is complete to address potential pressure loss and coloured water.

The Township of Ramara appreciates the cooperation and understanding of its residents during this important repair work.
